LADIES' DAY PROCEDURE

- Members must report to the pro shop 30 minutes before tee time. If you have to make changes to your group, email Jean Walsh at spdthrower@outlook.com **prior to 5:00 PM on Tuesday before play.**
- If you have changes to your group OR if you are not signed up by Tuesday evening, please call the pro shop **by 5:00 pm Wednesday.**
- Notify both the pro shop and a member of your foursome if you are unable to keep your starting time on the play day.
- Fivesomes are not permitted.
- If you do not have a full team for team events, keep a scorecard with appropriate "pops", and the Tournament Committee will supply a blind draw.

NOTE: There is no provision for a blind draw for Chapman, Scrambles, and Shambles.

SIGN-UP PROCEDURE

- On-line sign-ups are available up to a month in advance using www.golfgenius.com and sign in with the GGID **RW2026.**
- Sign up only yourself and your foursome.
- If you attempt to sign someone up and her name is not in the list, they are already signed up with someone.
- Do not remove anyone's name but your own from the sign-up sheet.

PAIRINGS AND RESULTS

- Pairings will be emailed by Monday prior to Thursday play.
- Results will be emailed by Saturday morning following play. If you wish to view tee sheets, results, stats online, go to www.golfgenius.com and sign in with the GGID RW2026.

RWGC STANDING RULES

(Revised 2024)

USGA Rules will govern all play except as modified by local rules or such temporary rules as determined by the Rules Committee and approved by the Board of Directors.

ELIGIBILITY

Players must:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Must have a USGA handicap. To obtain an initial Handicap Index, USGA requires a minimum total of 54 holes to be played and posted, which can be made up of 9- and/or 18-hole acceptable scores.
- All players will play with their full handicap.

WEEKLY TOURNAMENT PLAY

- Weekly Tournament Play Payouts-Members play from either RED or SILVER tees. The Board-approved Payout budget is divided by the number of Tournament Dates. Payouts are paid as Washoe Pro Shop credit. Payout for a specific day is determined by how many players sign up for RED or SILVER tees.

Example: 60 ladies sign up for Day 1. 40 play from the RED and 20 from the SILVER tees. 2/3 will be awarded to the RED players and 1/3 will be awarded to SILVER players. Historically, 1st Gross, 1st Net and 2nd Net are paid per flight for EACH of the RED and SILVER tees.

SCORECARD PLUS MOBILE APP SCORE ENTRY

- Each group will have one scorecard with the GGID login printed on it.
- **One player in the group will keep the official paper scorecard which includes gross scores and a Red or Silver tee designation.**
- Each player is responsible for keeping her own score to check against the official score.
- **One person will be the official electronic scorer in the group who will enter gross scores using Mobile App Score Entry and GGID login printed on the official paper scorecard.**
- Scores may be entered electronically during or immediately after play.
- **NEW:** If a player “picks up” (does not hole out) on a hole a MAXIMUM SCORE will be entered equaling Par + 5. Par 3 hole is 8, Par 4 is 9 and Par 5 is 10.
Do NOT enter net double bogey nor any X’s on weekly RWGC playdays.
- In the case that a player does not play a hole (does not tee off) the score keeper shall leave the space blank.

- Players will be disqualified from the competition if any space is left blank, but scores will be posted to GHIN.
- Each player must check her hole-by-hole score and verify red or silver designation with the marker keeping the official scorecard. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- Scorecards must be signed by all players in the group and attested by the marker.
- Signed and attested scorecards should be turned into the Handicap Committee as well as electronic scores entered immediately after the round and before leaving the premises. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- Incomplete or incorrect cards may be disqualified.
- **The Handicap Committee will verify electronic scores using the official scorecard, check for required red and silver tee entries, and post scores to GHIN by midnight.**
- The Tournament Committee will break ties according to USGA recommended method in the USGA Handicap System and Golf Committee manual.

POSTING (NON RWGC playday) SCORES TO GHIN

- All OTHER scores obtained through play at any course during the GHIN posting season must be posted on the computer at the course or on GHIN.com.
- For an 18-hole score to be acceptable for handicap purposes, a minimum of 10 holes must be played. When 10-17 holes are played, the player will be required to post their score using the hole by hole option.
- For a 9-hole score to be acceptable for handicap purposes, all 9 holes must be played. If a player does not play at least 9 holes, the score is not acceptable for handicap purposes.

- **NET DOUBLE BOGEY**

For posting purposes, the maximum score a player can take on any hole is Net Double Bogey. Net Double Bogey is defined as double bogey plus any Strokes (pops) a player gets on a hole.

Example: Washoe #1 (par 4)

Player A gets two strokes or pops. Double bogey on a par 4 is 6. Add her 2 strokes, so the maximum score she can take is 8.

Player B gets 1 stroke. The maximum score Player B can take is double bogey plus 1. She can take a 7.

NORTHERN NEVADA POSTING DATES

- Posting begins March 15th and ends November 30th.

SILVER TEES/RED TEES

- Silver Tees will have their own rating. Players can opt to play the Silver tees every week or from time to time as they choose. There will be a box on the scorecard in line with their names that must be marked "S" if the player is playing the Silver tees that week,
- If the player is playing the Red tees the box must be marked "R".
- Silver Tee and Red Tee players are in separate competitions. A portion of the weekly payouts equal to the percentage of Silver Tee players to the total number of players will be allocated to the Silver Tee players.
- All players with a handicap above a 36 are encouraged to play the Silver Tees.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP: Silver and Red

- The tournament committee shall set dates, starting times, and deadline for entries in the tournament.
- The tournament will be 36 holes of flighted stroke play.
- Flight breakdown will be the same as in weekly tournaments.
- USGA and Local Rules shall apply as set forth by the Rules Committee.
- The player recording the lowest gross score from the Silver Tees will be Silver Club Champion and the player recording the lowest gross score from the Red Tees will be the Red Club Champion.
- Players recording the lowest net scores from each set of tees will be Net Champions.

Eligibility

- Player must have an established USGA handicap.
- Player must be a member in good standing (dues paid 60 days prior to the first day of the tournament).
- Player must have played a minimum of 5 rounds on RWGC play days during the current season from the respective tees (Red or Silver) to be eligible for that Championship.
- Players will play with full handicap.

Pairings

- The first day, players will be paired according to handicap index within flights.
- The second day, players will be paired according to gross score.

Awards

Awards per flight

- Prizes will be awarded to 1/3, or a fraction thereof, of each flight.
- Gross and net positions for both the Red and Silver Championship shall be paid equally.
- A player is entitled to only one prize.

USGA RULES OF GOLF APPLY

Please disregard any rules on the Washoe Course scorecard

- Preferred lies or “Winter Rules”: Local Rule E-3. When any part of a player’s ball touches part of the general area the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball within one scorecard length from the spot of the original ball.
- Lost Ball: Rule 18. A ball is deemed lost when it is not found three minutes after the player or partner begins to search for it. A ball does not become lost as a result of the player declaring it lost. A ball that is lost requires the player to play under penalty of one stroke under stroke and distance by playing again from where the previous stroke was made.
- Embedded Ball: There is no relief under this rule if the ball is anywhere except the general area. But if the ball is embedded on the putting green the player may mark the spot of the ball and lift, clean and repair damage caused by the ball’s impact, and replace the ball on its original spot. Relief for embedded ball – 16.3b
- Putting Green: There is no penalty for touching the line of play on the putting green as long as there is no improvement to the conditions affecting the stroke. The player is allowed to remove sand or loose soil on the putting green without penalty and repair damage such as ball marks, spike marks, scrapes and indentations caused by equipment and the flagstick, old hole plugs and animal tracks. There is no penalty for accidental movement of the ball on the putting green. Rule 13.1c(2)
- Penalty Areas: defined by stakes, lines, or physical features.
 - Yellow Penalty Areas (yellow lines or stakes) two relief options, stroke and distance and back on the line.
 - Red Penalty Areas (red lines or stakes) have the same options as yellow as well as an additional lateral relief option.
 - If a drop area is designated it is an additional option to the options outlined above.
- Out of bounds: Defined by the inside edge of white stakes, white lines, and/or property lines and fences (**NEW**: including concrete wall on right side of hole 10,) All balls Out of Bounds must be replayed from the previous spot under the Stroke and Distance Rule.
- Playing Two Balls When Uncertain What to Do. Rule 20.1c(3). A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls without penalty. The player must declare her intention to invoke this Rule, and which ball will be counted (at the time of invoking the Rule) if the Rules permit. She must report facts to the Tournament Committee before signing and returning her scorecard. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. The RWGC Tournament Committee will make the final decision.

- Yardage markers on the course are deemed equipment. If your ball rests on or the marker impedes your swing, you are entitled to free relief per Rule 16.
- Obstructions (Immovable): Any artificial object except integral objects and boundary objects. Examples include artificially surfaced roads and paths, buildings, sprinkler heads, drains, irrigation or control boxes, stakes, walls, railings and fences (but not when they are boundary objects that define or show the edge of the course).
- Obstructions (Movable): Golf carts, mowers, cars and other vehicles, trash cans, signposts, benches, players equipment, flagsticks and rakes. Obstructions are movable or immovable free relief as provided in Rules 15 and 16.
- Abnormal Course Conditions: Animal hole, ground under repair, immovable obstruction or temporary water. Free Relief as prescribed in Rule 16.1a.
 - Newly seeded areas cut to fairway height or less even if not so marked.
- Stones in bunkers: Rule 15.1 (Loose impediments). Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. If a stone or pebble impedes your swing or follow-through in the bunker, you may remove it without penalty.
- Provisional Ball: Another ball played in case the ball just played by the player may be out of bounds or lost outside of a penalty area. Players are encouraged to play a ball provisionally if there is a chance their ball may be lost outside a penalty area or out of bounds.
- Cell phones: As a courtesy to others the committee requests that players refrain from talking on their phones during play.

END OF YEAR AWARDS

Eclectic

- Eclectic flights will be determined based on the player's USGA Handicap Index on the last day of play eligible for eclectic competition and the number of players who signed up for the competition.
- When signing up for the eclectic competition, players must designate either the Red or Silver tees to count their eclectic scores.
- Players must participate in the tournament of the day for their scores to count toward eclectic.

Most Improved Golfers

- Must have USGA handicap.
- Must have recorded eight 18-hole rounds on RWGC play days at Washoe County Golf Course during the current season.
- Awards will be divided into three handicap divisions based on your handicap at the start of the season as follows:
 - i) Handicap Division I: 0 – 23
 - ii) Handicap Division II: 24 – 32
 - iii) Handicap Division III: 33 – 40+

Hole-In-One

- Any club member making a hole-in-one at Washoe County Golf Course or any accredited golf course other than Washoe County Golf Course will receive an award commemorating the event.

First time Birdies/Eagles

- Members making a birdie or an eagle **FOR THE FIRST TIME** must post the event on the bulletin board in the ladies 'locker room to receive an End of Year Award.

Break Awards

- Members breaking a gross score of 100, 90, or 80 **FOR THE FIRST TIME** will receive an End of Year award. Score must have been recorded at Washoe County Golf Course on Ladies' Day.

HIGH SIERRA TEAM PLAY INFORMATION

- Sign-up sheets will be posted every month to qualify for Team Play. Maximum handicap for Team Play is 36.
- Handicaps over 36 will be reduced to 36.
- Qualifying days vary. Check the calendar in the roster book.
- Team members are determined by the three lowest gross and three lowest net scores recorded on qualifying days. All players must qualify and compete to a maximum of 36 handicap.
- Teams of six members will compete with other teams of six members at six different golf courses for six months. See schedule below.
- FORMAT: Reno Points. Players will be paired with a teammate with whom they can share advice, but it is an individual stroke play game.
- The club with the most points accumulated over the six tournaments wins.
- If you belong to more than one club, you may represent only one club in team play for the season.

- No one likes to play with or follow a slow player. Be ready and prepared when it's your turn to hit.
- Please help your group be aware if your group falls behind.
- Keep up with the group in front of you. If you are unable to keep up, please allow the group behind you to play through.
- Keep any pre-shot practice short.
- Finish conversations after your shot.
- Use the carts efficiently so as not to waste time to get to each player's shot.
- Continuous putting is encouraged. Two players may leave the green if play is completed and get ready to tee off at the next hole.
