Golf/Course etiquette. It is inherent that each member have a working knowledge of the rules of golf to ensure that individually and as a group the rules are followed to the best of your ability.

Carts/Course Maintenance. Drive golf carts responsibly. Keep them out of unauthorized areas, away from the greens/tee boxes (as appropriate with your rated disability), and on designated paths as much as possible. Replace/fill divots, repair ball marks on greens and DO NOT remove balls from cup with putter head.
